

After School Care Program (ASCP) Frequently Asked Questions

- What are ASCP drop-off and pick up times?
Kindergarten students are dismissed at 2:00pm daily; students that are not picked up at 2:00pm will be checked in to KinderCare. (There is no KinderCare on Wednesdays because of early dismissal.) Students in grades 1-5 are dismissed at 3:00pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays (2:00pm on Wednesdays). All elementary students (Kinder-5th grade) that are not picked up at carpool will be checked in to ASCP at 3:15pm (2:15pm on Wednesdays). Middle school and high school students are dismissed at 3:15pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays (2:00pm on Wednesdays); students have the option of going to teachers' office hours (Team Time) after carpool at 3:30pm on Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays; those students that will attend Team Time will be checked in to ASCP afterwards, if their parent/guardian has not arrived, and students that are not attending Team Time will be checked in to ASCP at 3:30pm. Middle school and high school students that are not picked up at carpool on Wednesdays will be checked in to ASCP at 2:15pm; students that are attending Team Time on Wednesdays will need to check with an ASCP leader before going to a teacher's classroom. All students should be picked up by 6:00pm.
- What activities will students be doing at ASCP?
Students will have free play time on the playground and quiet homework time; students may ask an ASCP leader for homework help, if needed. Students will have an activity almost every day after homework time; activities include a Bible story, group game, and/or crafts. Fridays are movie days, as most teachers do not assign homework for the weekend.
- Does LACS have after-school sports?
To be determined, depending on the county's COVID protocols.
- What is Spartan training?
Spartan is obstacle course racing. Students in the Spartan program can challenge themselves physically and mentally, and it is a great program for exercise. Students will be running/sprinting, jumping

over walls, doing rings, etc.

- Are ASCP, after-school sports, and Spartan the same program?
No, these are three different programs.
