Position Summary:

The Extended Day Care Leader is responsible for supervising, fostering intellectual and spiritual growth, and providing a safe, engaging, age-appropriate, and fun environment for elementary, middle school, and high school students during the school year.

Responsibilities:

- Be available Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday 3-6pm, and Wednesday 2-6pm
- 18 years old, or older
- A passionate and creative individual who is comfortable in creating, organizing, and implementing activities for a group of children
- Has experience in supervising children (preferred, but not required)
- May have units in Early Childhood Education / Child Development (recommended, but not required)

Required Skills and Abilities:

- Show initiative and follow through in carrying out a structured weekly schedule consisting of biblical devotions, homework study hall, crafts, organized games, and free play
- Know and enforce school rules and regulations in team area and on the playground

- Always know the whereabouts of each child on your team by periodically taking roll
- Take change the maintain the cleanliness of team areas (i.e. wiping down tables and chairs)
- Maintain a safe outside (and sometimes inside) play environment by continually moving and monitoring ALL areas on the playground / blacktop and classrooms
- Enforce proper care of Extended Day Care classrooms / areas, games, sports equipment, and school supplies
- Maintain professional, respectful, and open communication with parents and families of Extended Day Care students
- Implement boundaries and follow disciplinary procedures described in the EDC Handbook; refer difficult behavior matters to the Extended Day Care Director
