What core-academic classes do Kindergarten students take?

LACS Kindergarteners are provided instruction in Reading, Writing, Vocabulary, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Bible. Each class is taught using a curriculum we have hand selected to be the best fit for our students at LACS.

What Co-Curricular (specialized) classes do Kindergarteners take?

At LACS we offer unparalleled opportunities for enrichment classes. Students receive weekly instruction from specialized teachers in Art, Music, Physical Education, STEM, and Computers.

When does Kindergarten get to play?

When outside Kindergarten students get to enjoy their own special playground during two recess periods of 20 minutes each. In the classroom students often play while they learn! Whether using Math manipulatives, Science tools, or through acting out Bible and Literature stories our learning is fun and engaging.

Do Kindergarten students get to go on Field Trips?

Yes! Each year we take 3 educational field trips. This year we will visit a working farm to learn about the life cycle of plants, go to the Youth Science Institute at Vasona Park to learn about animals and their adaptations, and finally we will visit the planetarium to learn about our solar system. Field trips help us make learning come alive!

This year we have students who speak 4 different languages at home. Each year we have several students who are new to speaking English. Through teacher support, and our small class size, these students make progress quickly.
